Food Service Establishment Approval for Operation of a Pushcart or Mobile Food Unit on its Premises

Title 15A NCAC (North Carolina Administrative Code) 18A “Rules Governing the Sanitation of Food Service Establishments”.2638 (f) requires that “Pushcarts or mobile food units shall operate in conjunction with a permitted restaurant or commissary and shall report at least daily to the restaurant or commissary for supplies, cleaning, and servicing. Facilities, in compliance with this Section, shall be provided at the restaurant or commissary for storage of all supplies.”

In addition, .2640 (g) requires that “a servicing operations area shall be established at a restaurant for the mobile food unit. Potable water servicing equipment shall be installed, stored, and handled to protect the water and equipment from contamination. The mobile food unit’s sewage storage tank shall be thoroughly flushed and drained during servicing operation. All sewage shall be discharged to an approved sewage disposal system.”

to operate a pushcart or mobile food unit in conjunction with my establishment. I understand the applicable regulations require the unit to report daily to my establishment for supplies, cleaning and servicing, including replenishing of any on-board water supply and disposal of all solid and liquid wastes. I agree to allow all food and supplies for the unit to be stored on my premises and allow use of sinks and other applicable cleaning facilities. I understand that any sanitation deficiencies resulting at my establishment, even if directly or indirectly related to the operation of the pushcart or mobile food unit, will be reflected in the sanitation grade of my establishment. This agreement shall remain in effect as long as I am the establishment owner/operator, unless rescinded by notifying the pushcart or mobile food unit owner and Carteret County Environmental Health in writing.
